## **Chase SC Club Championships 2019**

### Meet Conditions and Information

1. The competition will be held under A.S.A. Laws and Technical rules of swimming. The event is to be licensed at Level 4 by the A.S.A. for entry into Level 3 meets and Staffordshire County Championships.  
The exemptions from this will be the under 9yr old age groups (25m events only).
2. The Pool length is 25m, six lanes and will be equipped with anti-wave lane ropes. All events will start at the deep end of the pool.
3. The competition is open to all members of the club with Category 1 and 2 membership of the ASA. A swimmer must have been a member of the club as of April 2019 and must be registered with the A.S.A.
4. Points will be awarded for each event at the conclusion of the event. 6pts for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 5pts for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 4pts for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 3pts for 4<sup>th</sup>, 2pts for 5<sup>th</sup> and 1 pt for 6<sup>th</sup> (in each age group). All competitors will receive awards appropriate to their place in their age group at the Club Presentation evening which will take place in the Autumn.
5. The competition will comprise of the following events:  
For swimmers under the age of 9yrs: 25m Butterfly, 25m Freestyle, 25m Breaststroke and 25m Backstroke.  
For swimmers age 9yrs: 50m Butterfly, 50m Freestyle, 50m Backstroke, 50m Breaststroke, 200m IM and 200m Freestyle.  
For swimmers age 10yrs and 11yrs: 50m Butterfly, 50m Freestyle, 50m Backstroke, 50m Breaststroke, 100IM, 200m IM and 200m Freestyle.  
For swimmers age 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs and 16yrs+: 100m Butterfly, 100m Freestyle, 100m Backstroke, 100m Breaststroke, 100IM, 200m IM and 200m Freestyle.
6. Ages will be at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019.
7. The event will take place over 2 sessions (22 and 23 June 2019) of maximum length 3 hours excluding warm-up of minimum length 30 minutes. Warm up will commence at 5pm on the 22 June and 3pm on the 23 June.
8. All events will be seeded on submitted entry times (where available) and each event will be on 'Heat Declared Winner' basis. If no entry times are available, swimmers will swim youngest first.  
Mixed heats will take place if there are too few competitors for an event.
9. The entry fee is £3.00 per event. All entries shall be on the official entry form available from the club website or noticeboard and should be received by Friday 17 May 2019.
10. Over the top starts may be used to maintain the scheduled timing of events.
11. Chase SC adheres to ASA Child Protection policy recommendations (Wavepower). Any person wishing to engage in any type of photography using any type of device, should register their details with staff at the spectator entry desk.
12. There will be a small charge for admission to the Championship.
13. Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters, Chase SC. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any person. The promoter reserves the right to make any changes that may be considered necessary for the safety and smooth running of the competition.
