Chase Autumn Roebuck- Meet Conditions

ENTRIES

1. The competition will be held under A.S.A. laws and technical rules. All entrants must be registered members of their association and of an affiliated club.
2. Entry forms can be downloaded from www.chaseswimmingclub.org.uk club entry must be by electronic entry file, using Sportsystem software. The file will be available to download on the 29th of august on our Roebuck website [Open Meet](#)

Individual entries can enter by filling in the Microsoft form [Chase Roebuck - Autumn Open 2026 - – Fill in form](#) which can also be found on our website.

3. All entry information, including ASA number and date of birth, must be checked to ensure accuracy before submission. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.
4. Where a number of swimmers are entering from one club, it is requested that one person coordinate the entries and submit one entry file. This person will then be the sole point of contact for that entering club. They will be responsible for entries, any queries relating to those entries, including any changes or withdrawals. This helps reduce confusion and miscommunication.
5. Entry fees are £7.50 per event for electronic entries. The entry fee for individual entries will be £8.00 to allow for the extra administrative costs.
6. We request that payments are made by bank transfer to Chase Swimming Club - account number 41900901 sort code 52- 21-00 using the reference "AUT26 club name". Summary sheets and coach pass applications should be emailed to meetsecretary.chasesc@gmail.com A list of all accepted entries will be posted to the Chase SC website shortly after the closing date.
7. Entries to this meet are first come first served. The date that entries are classed as received is the date that the meet administrator has received the completed entry file, summary sheet **and payment**. Upon submission of entries the number of poolside passes required **must** be indicated (names for passes can be given at a later date)
8. Entry times must not be faster than the published upper qualifying times (see separate document). Entries may be checked against the British rankings and any swimmer found to have a ranking time that exceeds the entry time before the date of entry will be excluded from the event, without refund. All entry times must be short course, actual or converted to a 25m pool. It is the responsibility of all competing clubs to ensure that entry times are accurate.

9. Once accepted, entries are published **NO** changes to any swimmers events will be made.
10. Once entries have been submitted either by club or individual we are unable to change them for a subsequently achieved faster time.
11. Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter and will be included within the able-bodied programme. A certificate of swimming disability will need to be given to the referee before the event.
12. In the event that an individual event is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. No entries will be accepted on the day of the meet under any circumstances. Chase Swimming Club reserves the right to include up to two Chase Swimming Club competitors per event, with no time. All swimmers entering this licensed competition must comply with the upper qualifying times.
13. All individual and club electronic entries plus payment (one bank transfer per club please), must be received by the promoter by the closing date of Saturday 3rd October 2026 midnight. We reserve the right to close the meet early if it becomes oversubscribed. Once the meet or a particular session is published as closed, **NO refunds** will be given for any entries already submitted, unless supported by a valid doctor's certificate or in the case of swimmers being selected for national, regional, or county events on the days of the event. Refunds will be processed as soon as possible.
14. The promoter reserves the right to refuse an entry. Incorrect or incomplete entries will not be accepted. All accepted and rejected entries will be posted on the Chase Swimming Club website prior to the event. **Once accepted only mistakes made by us will be corrected.** Rejected entries will receive a full refund. Once entries have been accepted, **no refunds will be given** unless supported by a valid doctor's certificate or in the case of swimmers being selected for national, regional, or county events on the days of the event. Refunds will be processed as soon as possible.
15. All events will be seeded on submitted entry times, with the slowest heat first and all events will be heat declared winners.
16. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
17. Confirmation of warm-up and start times of each session will be posted on the website. No warm down facility is available at this venue.

Withdrawals

18. To allow for smooth running of the meet, any withdrawals should be made by **12 noon, Thursday 22nd of October 2026** by emailing meetsecretary.chasesc@gmail.com, stating competitor name, club, event number and event name. If a swimmer has entered via their club, only their club coordinator should make contact to withdraw any swimmers from particular events or the whole meet.

Starts

19. A secondary strobe light will be used for starts, where it is requested by an athlete at the time of entry, subject to availability at the pool.

20. Over the top starts and backstroke ledges may be used.

Swimmer Supervision

21. All swimmers **MUST** be under the supervision of a coach and team manager at all times. Swimmers supervision is the responsibility of the team managers and coaches of the club with which they have entered, this *includes individual entries*. This particularly applies during breaks between sessions and in areas where Chase Swimming Club cannot monitor activity, such as showers, changing rooms and public areas. Coach/team manager ratios should be followed in accordance with Swim England Team Manager, Coach and Chaperone Policy (SE1048). If this is not possible due to entering *individually*, please arrange to team up with another competing club, or if you as a parent have the correct credentials outlined by Swim England to be poolside then please request a poolside pass for the sessions required. You may request for Chase SC to supervise individual entries, However this cannot be guaranteed, Chase SC will need to assess if we have the correct number of TM's and coaches to cover individual entries and our own swimmers
22. It is the responsibility of coaches and team managers to ensure that their swimmers report to the marshaling area in time for the start of their race.
23. Coaches and team managers are expected to supervise their own swimmers during the warm-up, following the published schedule.

Results

24. Results may be displayed during the meet and Live Results will be published on the Chase Swimming Club website during the meet.

Awards/Medals

25. Medals will be awarded to the first three places, in each age group, per event. Medals will be awarded to disability swimmers who PB in the events they enter and, where more than one swimmer competes under the same disability classification they will be ranked accordingly. Medals can be collected from the medals' table when announced.

Poolside Passes

26. Poolside passes are available for coaches and team managers supporting competing swimmers at a cost of £12 per day, £20 per weekend and includes a light breakfast, lunch and refreshments. Passes should be ordered prior to the meet using the application form and can be collected on the day. Passes must be worn at all times when on poolside and in designated swimmers' areas. It is the responsibility of attending clubs to ensure that poolside passes are only issued to people who have an up-to-date DBS and they are adequately staffed in terms of Swim England ratios. No parents will be permitted to enter the poolside.

General

27. A photographer may be present during the meet, please see website closer to date of meet for details.
28. Chase Swimming Club takes no responsibility for loss or damage to personal possessions during this meet. Swimmers, coaches, team managers and spectators are advised to keep their belongings in a safe place at all times.
29. The programme will be available on the website to download.
30. Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters, Chase Swimming Club.

Individual entries

All swimmers **MUST** be under the supervision of a coach and team manager at all times. Coach/team manager ratios should be followed in accordance with Swim England Team Manager, Coach and Chaperone Policy (SE1048). If this is not possible due to entering individually, please arrange to team up with another competing club, or if you as a parent have the correct credentials outlined by Swim England to be poolside then please request a poolside pass for the sessions required.

You may request for Chase SC to supervise individual entries, however this cannot be guaranteed, Chase SC will need to assess if we have the correct number of TM's and coaches to cover individual entries and our own swimmers.

Parking

There is plenty of parking at WV active Central and is free for the duration of the meet. Additional parking is available nearby, around the perimeter of West Park.

Spectators

Spectator tickets will be available to purchase in advance nearer the time. Details of which will be communicated to entered clubs and will also be shown on the Chase Roebuck page on the Chase Swimming Club website.

Officials and Volunteers Request
