Meet Conditions and Information

VENUE	Cheslyn Hay Leisure Centre
POOL	The pool length is 25m, it has six lanes and anti-wave lane ropes
AGE GROUPS	Open to all members of Chase Swimming Club with Category 1 and 2 ASA Membership who have been members since 1 July 2023. Swimmers aged under 9 years will only swim 25m events Age as at 31 December 2023
CLOSING DATE date	Saturday 9th September 2023. No entries will be accepted after this date
EVENTS	For swimmers <u>under the age of 9yrs</u>: 25m Butterfly, 25m Freestyle, 25m Breaststroke and 25m Backstroke. For swimmers <u>age 9yrs</u>: 50m Butterfly, 50m Freestyle, 50m Backstroke, 50m Breaststroke, 200m IM and 200m Freestyle. For swimmers <u>age 10yrs and 11yrs</u>: 50m Butterfly, 50m Freestyle, 50m Backstroke, 50m Breaststroke, 100 IM, 200 IM and 200m Freestyle. For swimmers <u>age 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs and 16yrs+</u>: 100m Butterfly, 100m Freestyle, 100m Backstroke, 100m Breaststroke, 100 IM, 200 IM and 200m Freestyle.

1. The competition will be held under A.S.A. Laws and Technical rules of swimming. The event is to be licensed at Level 4 by the ASA for entry into Level 3 meets and Staffordshire County Championships.
2. The exemptions from this will be the under 9yr old age groups (25m events only).



3. The Pool length is 25m, six lanes and will be equipped with anti-wave lane ropes. All events will start at the deep end of the pool.
4. The competition is open to all members of the club with Category 1 and 2 membership of the ASA. A swimmer must have been a member of the club as of April 2020 and must be registered with the ASA.
5. Points will be awarded for each event at the conclusion of the event. 6pts for 1st place, 5pts for 2nd place, 4pts for 3rd, 3pts for 4th, 2pts for 5th and 1 pt for 6th (in each age group). All competitors will receive awards appropriate to their place in their age group.
6. The competition will comprise of the events on the previous page.
7. Ages will be at 31 December 2023.
8. The event will take place over 2 sessions (17 and 18 September 2023) of maximum length 3 hours excluding warm-up of minimum length 30 minutes. Warm up will commence at 4pm on 17 September and 4pm on 18 September.
9. All events will be seeded on submitted entry times (where available) and each event will be on 'Heat Declared Winner' basis. If no entry times are available, swimmers will swim youngest first.
10. Heats will be mixed (ie boys and girls).
11. The entry fee is £4.00 per event. All entries shall be on the official entry form available from the club website and should be received by Friday 1 September 2023. Refunds will only be made for withdrawals on medical grounds with supporting evidence. Refunds for other withdrawals notified prior to the event will be at the discretion of the promoter.
12. Over the top starts may be used to maintain the scheduled timing of events.
13. Swimmers should NOT wear FINA approved racing suits for this event. Training costumes and jammers must be worn.
14. Chase SC adheres to ASA Child Protection policy recommendations (Wavepower). No photography or filming will be permitted.
15. There will be a small charge for spectator admission to the Championships.
16. There are currently no Covid-19 restrictions in place. However, Chase Swimming Club reserves the right to make any necessary changes to the meet arrangements should Government or Swim England guidance in relation to Covid-19 change before the meet date.
17. Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters, Chase SC. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any person. The promoter reserves the right to make any changes that may be considered necessary for the safety and smooth running of the competition.
